

Amazing Adjectives

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Explore adjectives to help students more deeply understand these women and themselves!

- Assign a woman to one student (or groups of students) and have them identify adjectives used in the biography for that woman.
 - Have them generate synonyms for those adjectives and any other words they think describe that woman. If they are unsure what some words mean, have them look up and define words as well
- Have students create acronyms for their own names with adjectives that celebrate who they are.
 - Here is an example for *Janelle*:
 - J - Joyous
 - A - Amiable
 - N - Nostalgic
 - E - Energetic
 - L - Loyal
 - L - Loving
 - E - Empathetic
- Ready for a challenge?
 - Choose challenging adjectives and have students create posters with the word and symbols that describe it. Here is an example:
 - Word: *Raucous - making or constituting a disturbingly harsh and loud noise.*
 - How might you visualize the definition of this word? Pictures of people screaming, big bold letters, exclamation marks, etc.
 - Have students create name tags with each letter representing the adjective they wrote (similar to [THIS](#) project).
